Site Access and Occupation.

The successful tenderer will:

- 1. Upon award and before establishing on site be introduced to Craig Davis, City of Canada Bay's Co-ordinator Parks & Sports Fields.
- 2. Consult with Craig and provide a site management plan for approval.
- 3. Negotiate all changes of site access and perimeter with Craig.

Please note that the sports field perimeter is soft after spells of wet weather.

Any damage to the sports field will need to be restored to the satisfaction of Craig Davis who will provide a list of endorsed sports field restoration contractors.

Occupation of the perimeter of the sports field to undertake the drainage works and to provide construction access to the front of the building will need to be negotiated with the users of the sports field. Please note that the cricket season commences at the end of September and preparation for the cricket season begins at the end of August.

An additional suggestion for access to the construction site is provided in the attached PDFs. These are provided as guides only. Please note that the site specific management plan is to be reviewed and approved by City of Canada Bay.

An application has been made for the approval of a kerbside work zone extending from the bus zone south of the site to the street light pole at the north of the site. Note that the kerb side lane is in excess of 5m wide.

Keys to the adjacent public toilets can be provided to the successful tenderer for use by site staff.
